2nd Annual RTR Jr. High School Duathlon

A duathlon, open to all 6-8th grade students (as of fall semester 2012), will take place from 9am to 2pm at Centennial Park. Participants will run 2 miles through the park, then bike 2.75 miles, then finish with a 2 mile run.

The event is chip timed by Accusplit Timing and girls and boys trophy winners for 1st, 2nd and 3rd place in each grade will be posted the following day. A traveling trophy for the school with the most participants will also be awarded. New this year is a family team category!

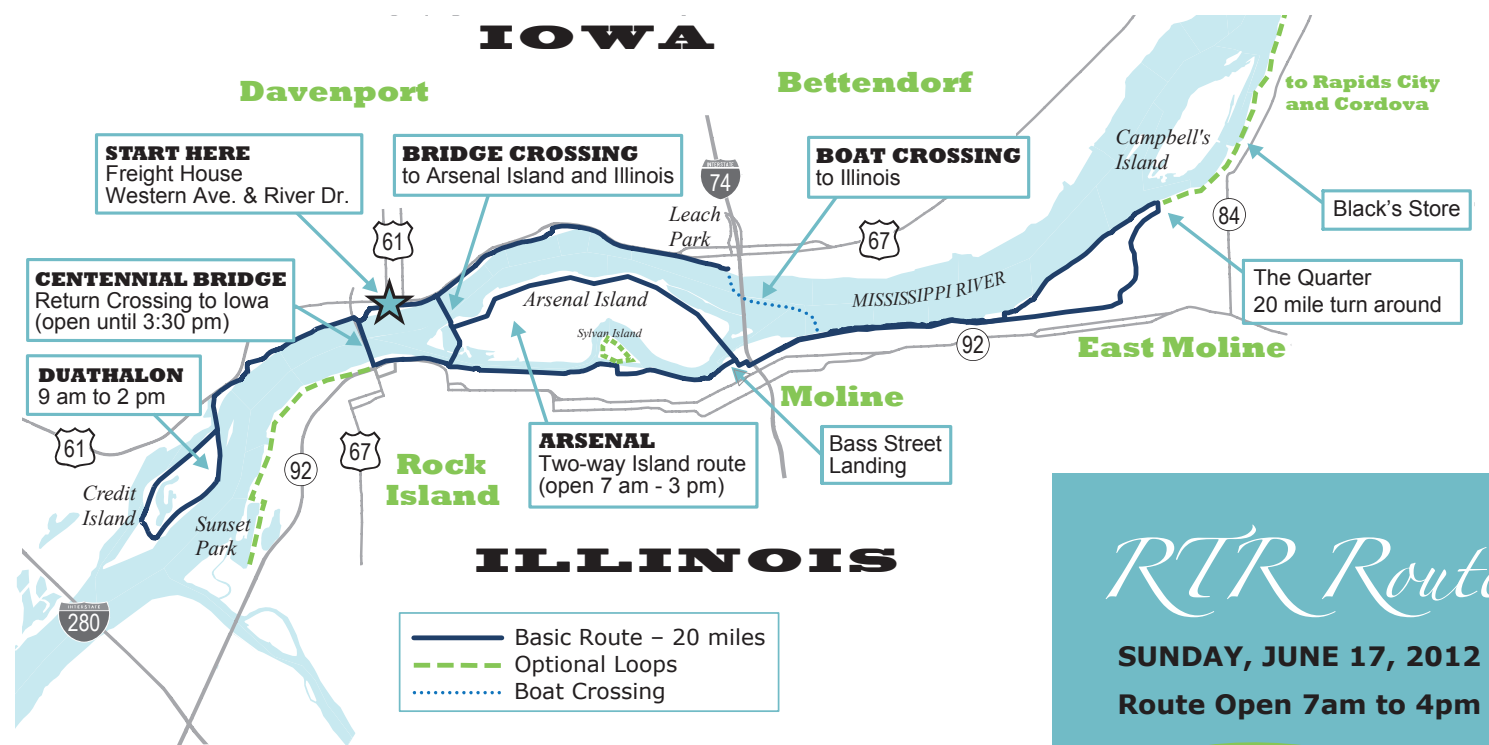
This event, organized by race director Larry Davis, (ladavis58@yahoo.com) and the Scott Co. Y, is free when accompanied by a paid adult. Register with this form or at www.riveraction.org where you can also get details for conditioning and drill clinics at the Y.

Kids Ride Free, sponsored by Trinity Regional Health Systems, offers opportunities for children 16 and under to ride free with a paying adult.

The Route – Pedal the basic route of 20 miles or follow the signs for rides of up to 60 miles. Begin at The Freight House, Davenport, proceed to Leach Park, Bettendorf and cross the Mississippi River to Moline on the Celebration Belle Riverboat. Those crossing by bridge will cross the Arsenal Island Bridge and continue the route to the suggested turn around at The Quarter, returning to Davenport via Arsenal Bridge or Centennial Bridge (open until 3:30). Riders can turn around at various spots on the route. All total, you can ride through nine communities plus Arsenal Island and mountain bike on Sylvan Island.

Riverboat Crossing Option – At Bettendorf's Leach Park, cross the Mississippi River on the Celebration Belle Riverboat while your bike goes across on a barge. At the Illinois landing, pick up your bike and continue your trip. See registration form for boat crossing times and details.

Arsenal Bridge Crossing Option – Take the Davenport path and ride across the Arsenal Bridge. Riders can also ride across Arsenal Island to Moline. Bridge crossing times are on the registration form. Must show photo ID.
