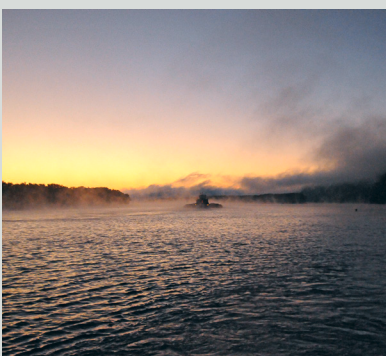
The workshop will be held in the new, comfortable, and technologically well-equipped classroom of Western Illinois University Quad City.
